

Flat rate shipping per product Extension User Guide

About This Extension:

Flat Rate Shipping Per Product extension is the most useful and powerful flat rate shipping module for Magento. It allows you to specify a flat rate shipping amount for each product individually.

Features:

- Flat rate shipping per product extension is solution for incorrect shipping rates.
- You can add the specify rate to your product. It shows in payment method.
- This extension avoids incorrect shipping payments. And also you can select the normal price or flat rate for the shipping.
- Flat rate shipping methods are appearing in the shipping methods option.
- It allows you to specify the flat shipping rates for specific products in the product catalog on your store.
- It allows you to select a default shipping rate value for certain product groups on your store. You can even set default value for products where shipping rate is not mentioned.
- Country specific shipping rates can be assigned to the products in the product catalog on your store.
- While creating orders from Magento admin panel admin can fetch all the shipping method applied for selected item.
- When the shipping rate field is left blank, this product extension hides the shipping rate field at the consumer end.

Benefits:

- Specify flat shipping rates for any or all products in catalog on your store.
- This extension is found to be compatible with bundled, configurable and other product types on your web store.
- Products with unspecified flat rate automatically use site wide default rates, which can be set as ranges.

Installation:

Steps to install this extension

We recommend creating a backup of your site before installing any new extension, especially if it is a live site

- Please make sure you've downloaded extension package compliant with your magento version. The Compliance information is stated in the package filename. Once you've downloaded and unzipped the archive.
- Upload the contents of the module package to the **Magento root folder**. This will not overwrite the existing Magento folders or files, only the new contents will be added.

- After uploading is done, Log in your Magento administration panel to refresh cache by way go to **System > Cache Management**. Select all caches and take action "**Refresh**" then submit.
- You can check whether the module is enabled or not in Admin area. Go to **System > Configuration**, under configuration select "Advanced" > If the Module is Enabled You can see option "Enable" for "Mg_Fsperitem".

UnInstallation:

In Admin area, go to **System > Configuration**, under Configuration select "Advanced" > Click on Disable Modules Output and select "Disable" for "Mg_Fsperitem" and click **Save Config** button Clear the store cache under **System > Cache Management**.
