

PayPal Adaptive Extension User Guide

About This Extension:

- Magento PayPal Extension uses the PayPal Adaptive Payments API to let you create and manage parallel / chained payments, payment preapprovals, and refunds. Send money peer-to-peer, split payments in both parallel and chained models, and accept guest payments.
- PayPal adaptive extension allows parallel & chained payment method in PayPal.
- PayPal adaptive extension is useful when buyer make a parallel & chained type of payment for items from multiple suppliers.
- In this PayPal adaptive extension, you can manage the suppliers, transactions & refunds and other settings.
- You can add the supplier's data & you can set the adaptive payment type chained or parallel. After you set the suppliers or vendors data in backend for the product that will show in frontend. In frontend you can choose the PayPal adaptive in payment methods.
- Your payment summary and list of different suppliers appear in this step. PayPal adaptive extension is so benefit to sellers and the buyers.

Installation:

Steps to install this extension

We recommend creating a backup of your site before installing any new extension, especially if it is a live site

- Please make sure you've downloaded extension package compliant with your magento version. The Compliance information is stated in the package filename. Once you've downloaded and unzipped the archive.
- Upload the contents of the module package to the **Magento root folder**. This will not overwrite the existing Magento folders or files, only the new contents will be added.

- After uploading is done, Log in your Magento administration panel to refresh cache by way go to **System > Cache Management**. Select all caches and take action "**Refresh**" then submit.
- You can check whether the module is enabled or not in Admin area. Go to **System > Configuration**, under configuration select "Advanced" > If the Module is Enabled You can see option "Enable" for "Mg_PaypalAdaptive".

UnInstallation:

In Admin area, go to **System > Configuration**, under Configuration select "Advanced" > Click on Disable Modules Output and select "Disable" for "Mg_PaypalAdaptive" and click **Save Config** button
Clear the store cache under **System > Cache Management**.
