

# Multi-vendor market place price comparison Extension User Guide

## About This Extension:

Multi-vendor market place price comparison extension is as same as Multi-vendor market place and in addition comes with price comparison. This extension gives merchants the ability to sell products through multiple drop shippers, vendors, and suppliers. It allows vendors to manage their own products, and notify them automatically of their new orders. The magento store owner will have complete control over magento features. Store owner should able to give provide granular control to vendors.

## Features:

- Ability create and maintain Vendors both manually(admin backend) and automatically via vendor registration form
- vendors can have their own and own store design
- Ability to checkout multiple vendors products in single order
- Ability to setup different commissions per Vendor
- Vendor will be able to setup promotions(Add on extension)
- Orders and shipments can be processed per Vendor
- Site admin is able set permissions for editing catalog per vendors via resource permissions
- Ability to create as many vendor roles as possible
- Ability to configure email templates by vendors( marketplace Add on extension)
- Vendor can access sales reports
- Vendors can set shipping cost per product(marketplace Add on extension)

- Marketplace gives you all the add-ons necessary to configure and automate drop shipping workflow, variety of ways to integrate with vendors, many shipping options, track and manage orders and shipments, charge commissions, pay vendors, promote products and sellers, and fully configure and control customer/vendor interaction

## Installation:

Steps to install this extension

**We recommend creating a backup of your site before installing any new extension, especially if it is a live site**

- Please make sure you've downloaded extension package compliant with your magento version. The Compliance information is stated in the package filename. Once you've downloaded and unzipped the archive.
- Upload the contents of the module package to the **Magento root folder**. This will not overwrite the existing Magento folders or files, only the new contents will be added.

- After uploading is done, Log in your Magento administration panel to refresh cache by way go to **System > Cache Management**. Select all caches and take action "**Refresh**" then submit.
- You can check whether the module is enabled or not in Admin area. Go to **System > Configuration**, under configuration select "**Advanced**" >If the Module is Enabled You can see option "Enable" for "Mg\_Vendorpanel", "Mg\_VendorCommision", "Mg\_VendorConfiguration", "Mg\_VendorRegistation", "Mg\_Vendorstore", "Mg\_PaypalAdaptive", "Mg\_Fsperitem", and "Mg\_PriceCompare".

## UnInstallation:

In Admin area, go to **System > Configuration**, under Configuration select "**Advanced**" >Click on Disable Modules Output and select "Disable" for "Mg\_Vendorpanel", "Mg\_VendorCommision", "Mg\_VendorConfiguration", "Mg\_VendorRegistation", "Mg\_Vendorstore", "Mg\_PaypalAdaptive", "Mg\_Fsperitem", "Mg\_PriceCompare" and click **Save Config** button Clear the store cache under **System > Cache Management**.
